The behaviors are grouped into a set of 24 Specific Skills which make up the six Core Skills of TeamMate 360: Developing Team Plans, Team Leadership, Team Communication, Working as a Team, Performance Management and Exploiting Technology.

Virtual team assessment system

- designed using academic best practice material for virtual teams and the experience of the project participants.
- a simple, but effective system, which provides a snapshot picture of the capability of the virtual team's functioning.
- is for managers and entrepreneurs who manage remote workers and team members or virtual teams. A remote worker might work from home, works as a sales representative only coming into the office occasionally or is member of a project team.

TeamMate 360 Assessment




TeamMate 360 is a web-based assessment system that collects and collates feedback about from the assessment of the performance of team leaders and managers in the six Core Skills. It includes an on-line questionnaire which is completed by several members of the team. Then TeamMate 360 analyses the questionnaires and produces a short report.



TeamMate360 Report

It summarizes the results of the TeamMate 360 questionnaires and includes graphs and charts explaining the results of the

assessment.






TeamMate360 Report
